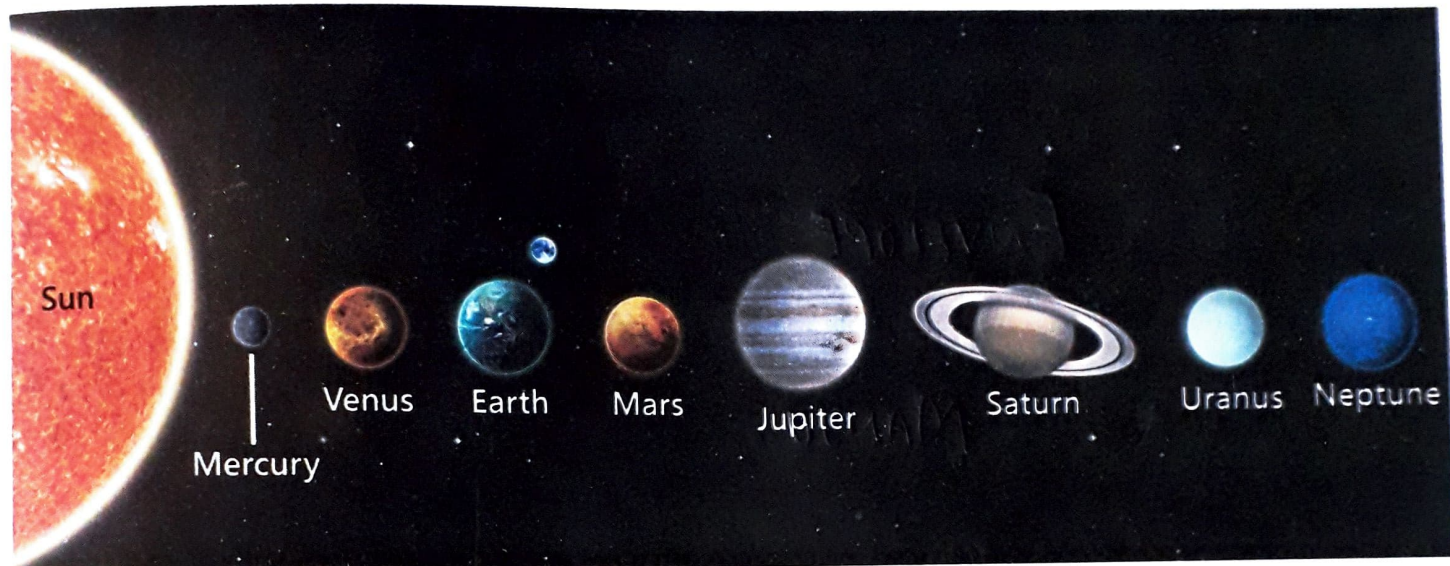


# 14 Meet The Planets
