

Look at the following sentences.



The boy is playing cricket.



This **bat** is mine.

That girl is painting a picture.



The **baby** is crying.

The noun 'boy' is the name of a male. It is a masculine gender. The word masculine means male. Thus, names of all male persons or animals are in the masculine gender; for example,

king, man, acto<u>r</u>, son, horse

The noun 'girl' is the name of a female. It is a feminine gender. The word feminine means female. Thus, the names of all female persons or animals are in the feminine gender; for example,

queen, woman, actress, daughter, cow

The noun 'bat' is the name of a thing. A thing without life can neither be male nor female. The name of such a thing is a **neuter gender**. The word 'neuter' means neither. So a thing which is neither male nor female belongs to the neuter gender; for example,

chair, table, house, pen, book, school

The noun 'baby' may be used for a male baby or a female baby. The name is common for a male or a female. Thus, the names which are common to both males and females are in the common gender; for example,

friend, parent, pupil, person, child, cousin, student, teacher, baby, bird



How Feminines of Nouns are Formed

There are three ways of forming a feminine gender of a noun from a masculine noun.

I. By adding -ess to the masculine:


