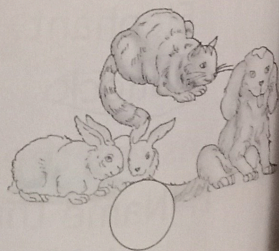
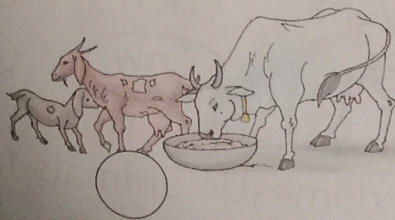
A. Save Animals
